- In the right conditions a seed will begins to germinate. The roots will grow first and then a shoot will appear. This continues to grow into a young plant, then a mature plant with flowers.

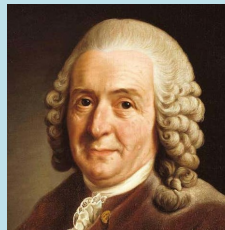
