### Beach bag nouns bank

### “Come to the beach” persuasive sentences bank

**Viens à la plage!** – Come to the beach!

**On peut nager** – You can swim

**On peut faire des châteaux de sable** – You can build sandcastles

**On peut jouer au ballon** – You can play with a ball

**On peut jouer aux raquettes** – You can play with rackets

**On peut sauter dans les vagues** – You can jump in the waves

**Il fait chaud** – It is hot

**Il y a du soleil** – It is sunny

**N'oublie pas...** – Don't forget...

### Grammar

Use conjunctions such as : “**et**” – “and” “**aussi**” – also” to extend your sentences.

### Grammar

The phrase “**on peut**” translates to “**you can**” in English. When using “**on peut**”, it must be followed by a verb in its infinitive form. For example: **on peut avoir** (you can have), **on peut faire** (you can do), **on peut manger** (you can eat) etc.

### Phonics

“**ette**” (casquette, serviette, raquettes)

“**qu**” (casquette, raquettes)

“**er**” (nager, jouer, sauter)

**Final silent consonant:** on peut, dans, tongues, maillot, viens, châteaux, raquettes, vagues, chaud
